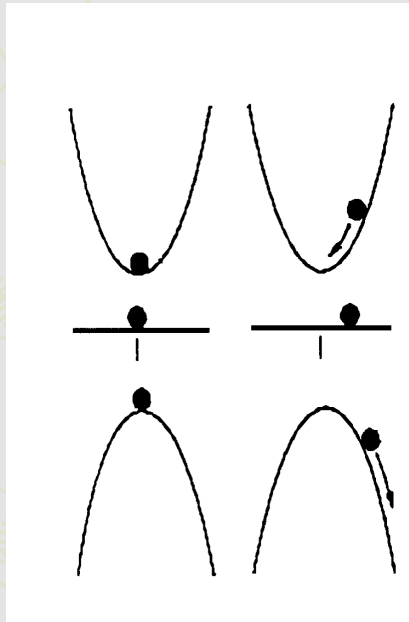

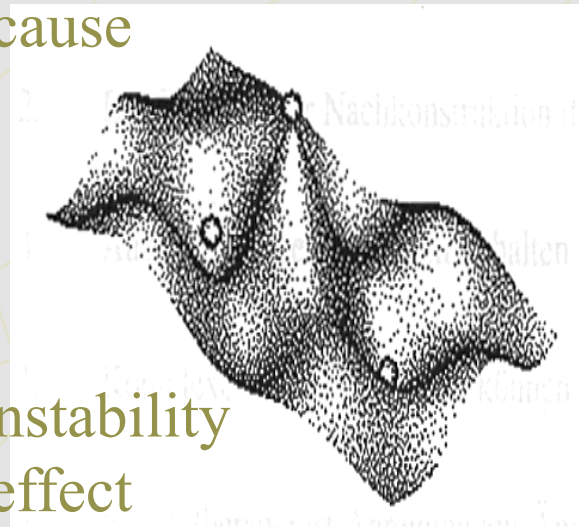


Landscape of potentialities

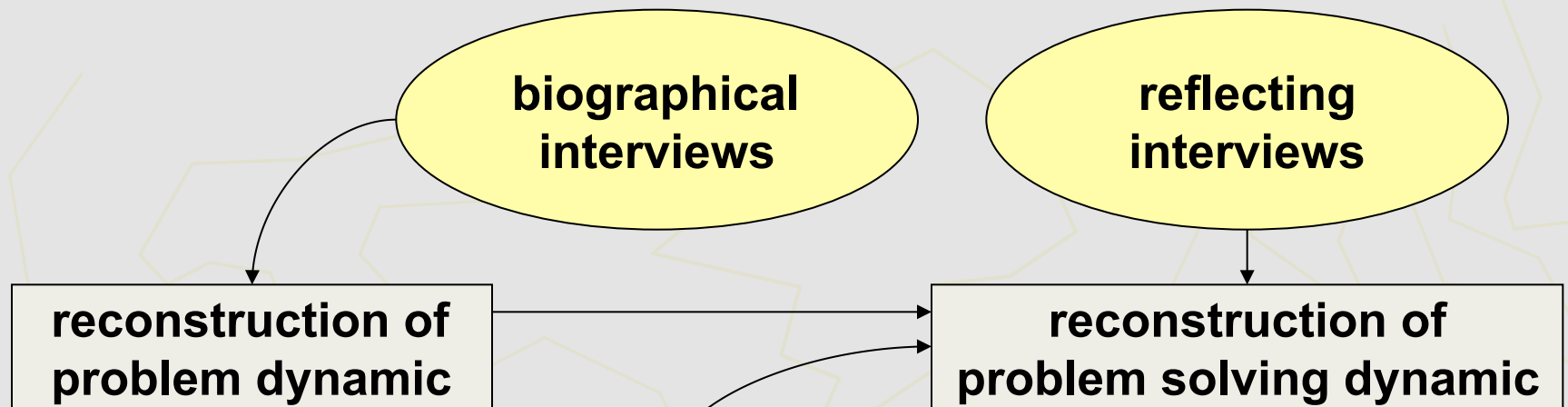
Research Goals

- ▶ Detailed understanding of the processes of integration and exclusion in the interaction of individual activities / pattern building and their social structuralisations (in particular to the social help system)
- ▶ Examination of a procedure that is adequate to effectively accompany and document the complicated processes of (Re) integration and is probably suited for the advancement of the practice.

Research Design

- ▶ 16 intensive case scenarios
- ▶ Cases of people who just left prison, women's refuge, girls' refuge or in-patient mental institutions.
- ▶ Qualitative Paradigm
- ▶ Longitudinal design for characterization and reconstruction of the dynamic (5 months to 1 year)
- ▶ Multiple data collection

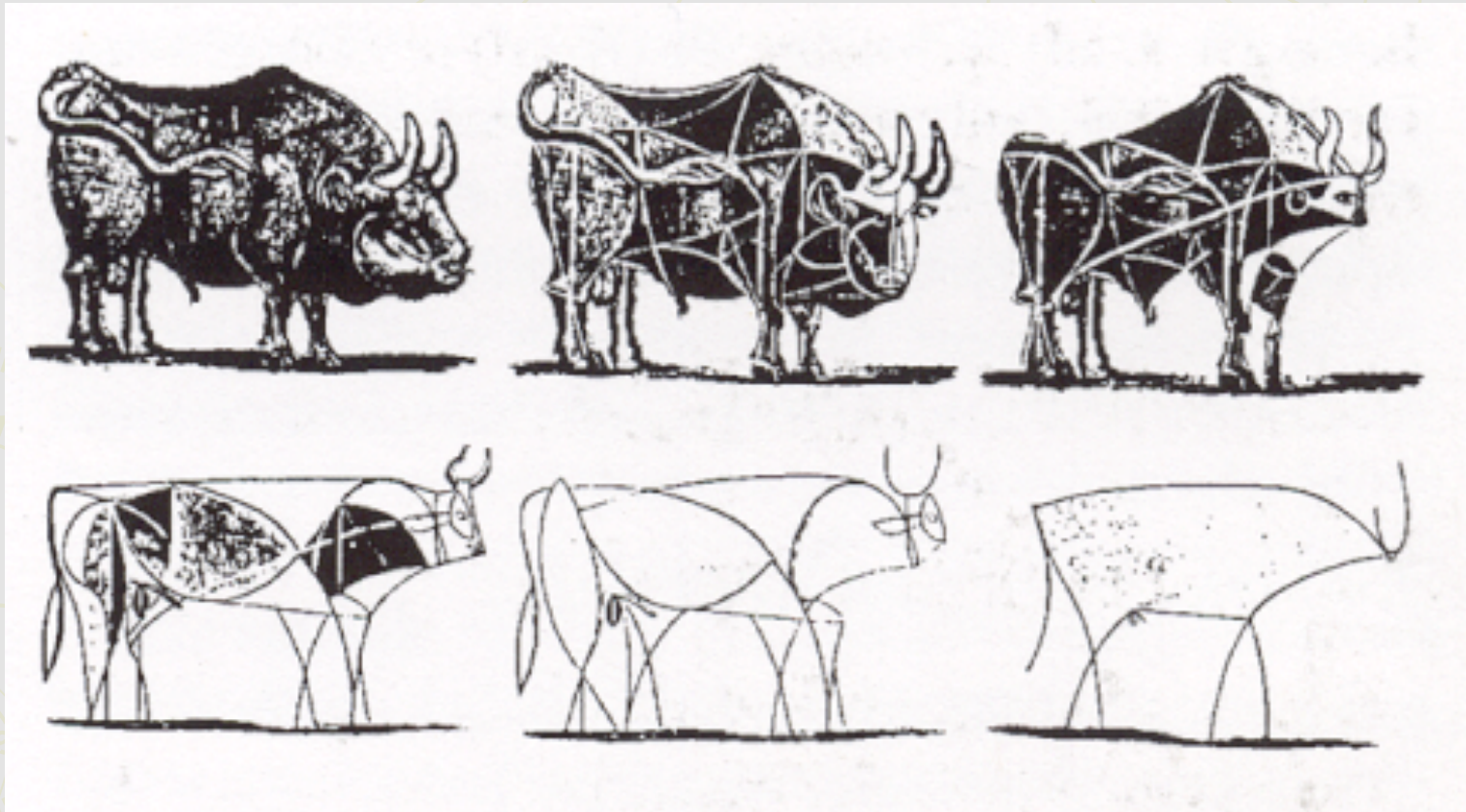

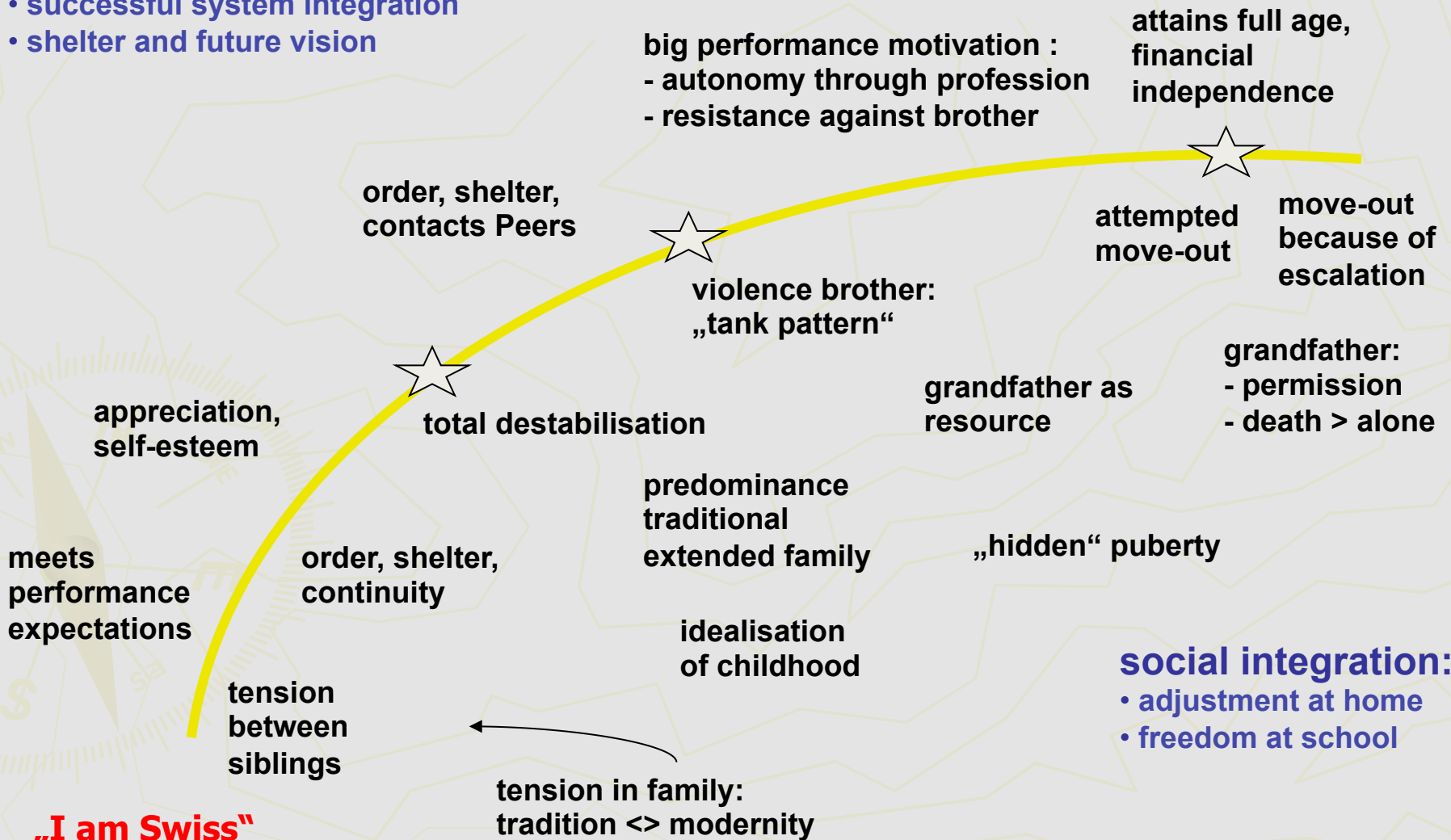
Process curve Alex to women's refuge



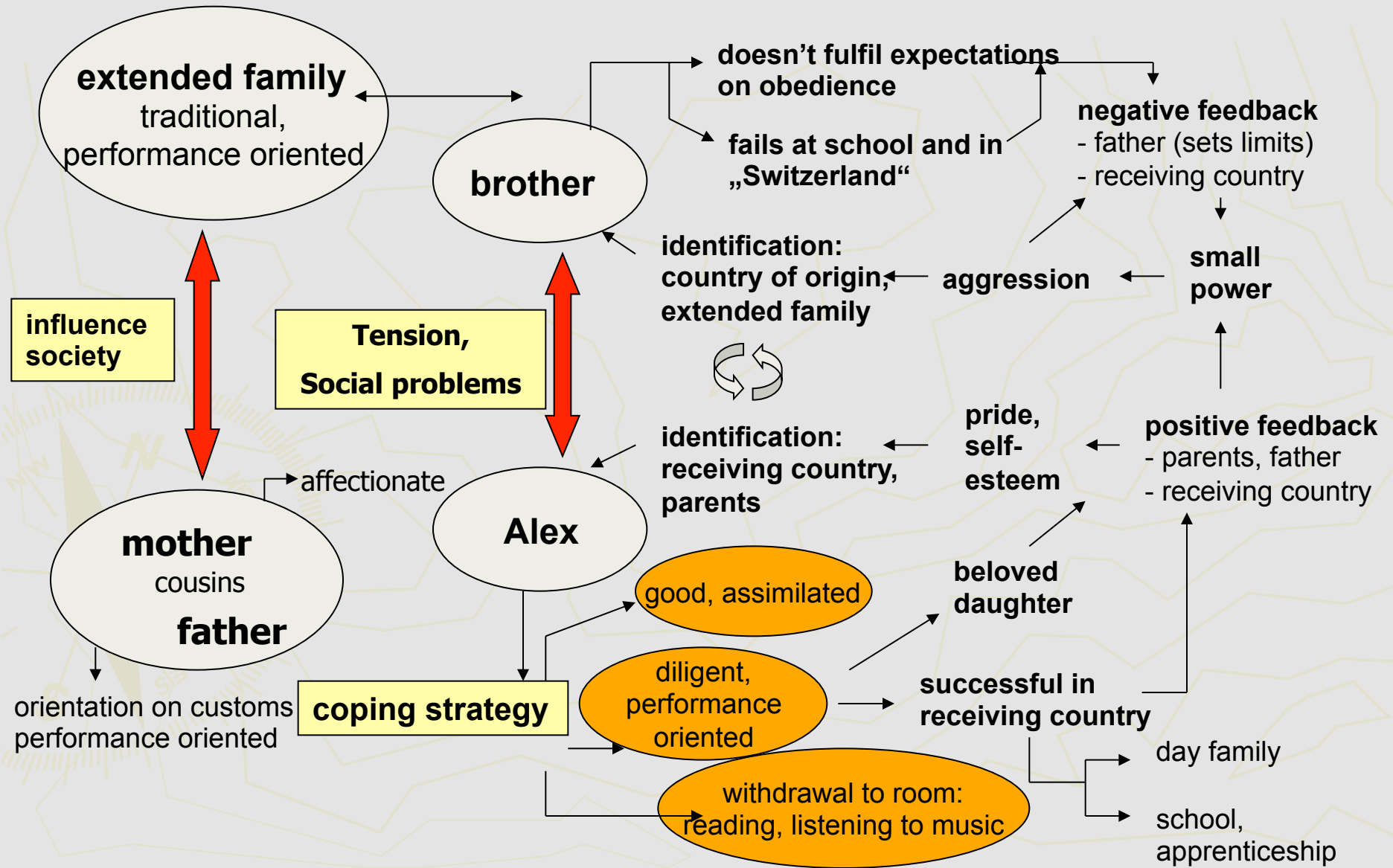
Dynamic Structure of Process Curve

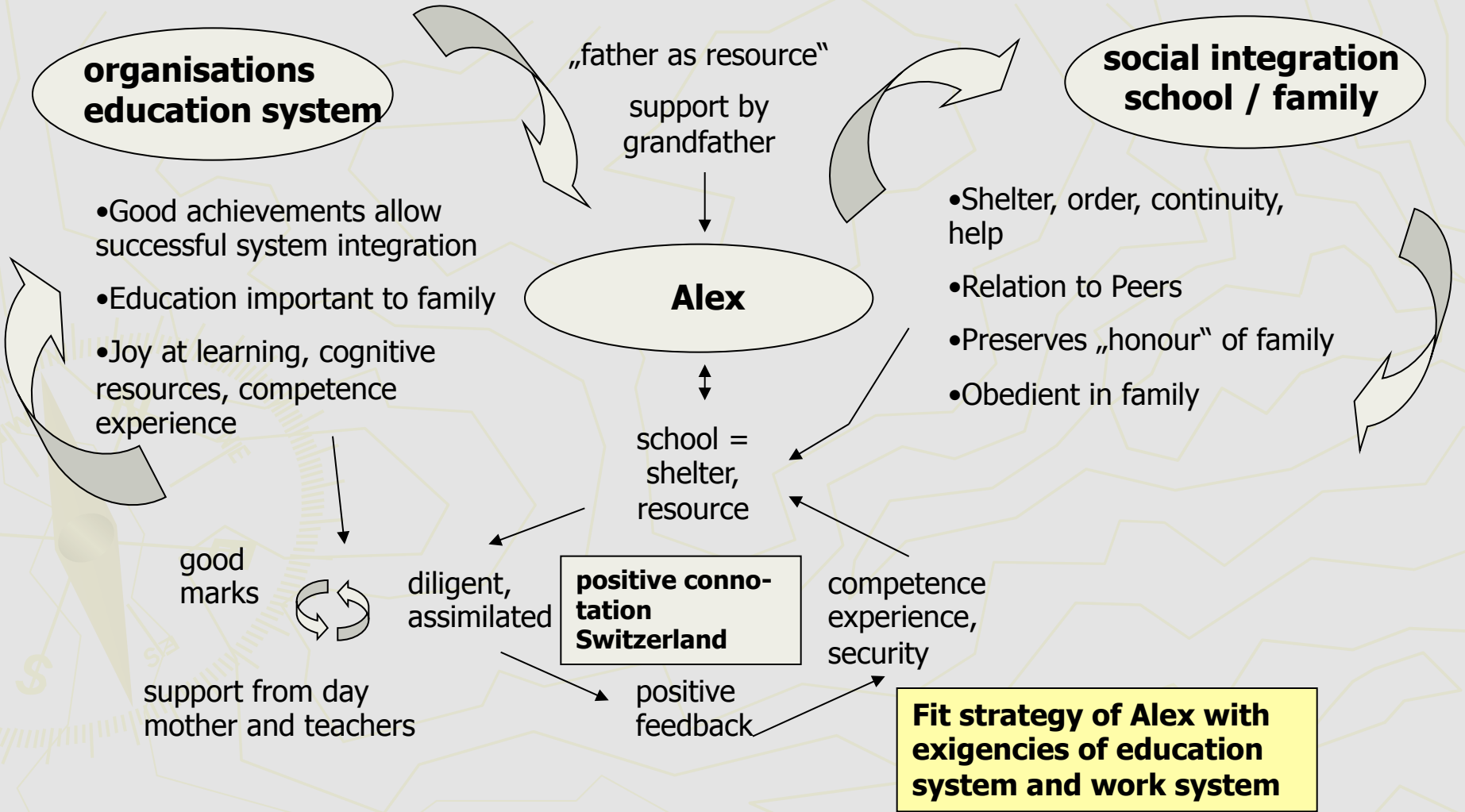

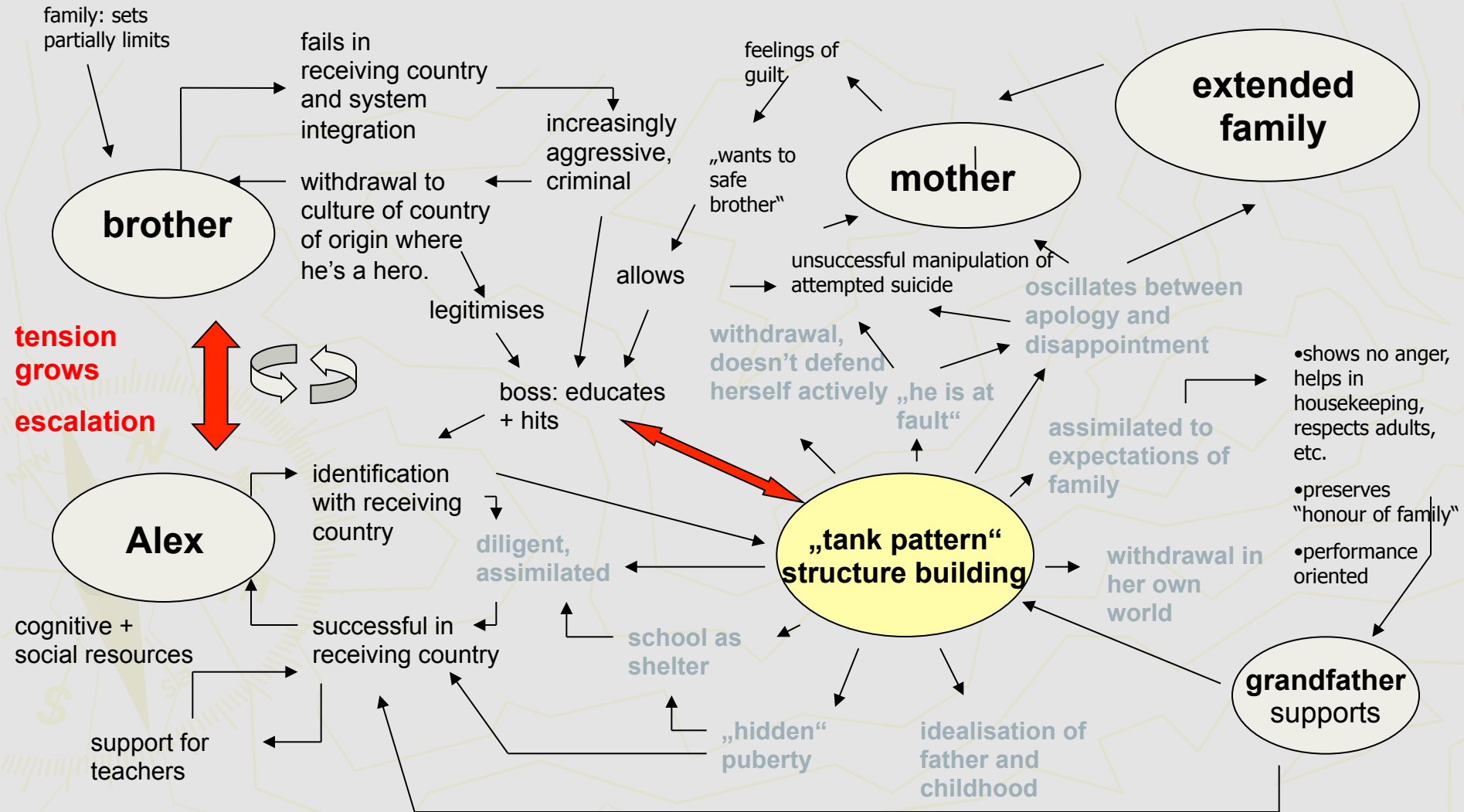
Social Figuration Family System / Problem Genesis (before death of father)

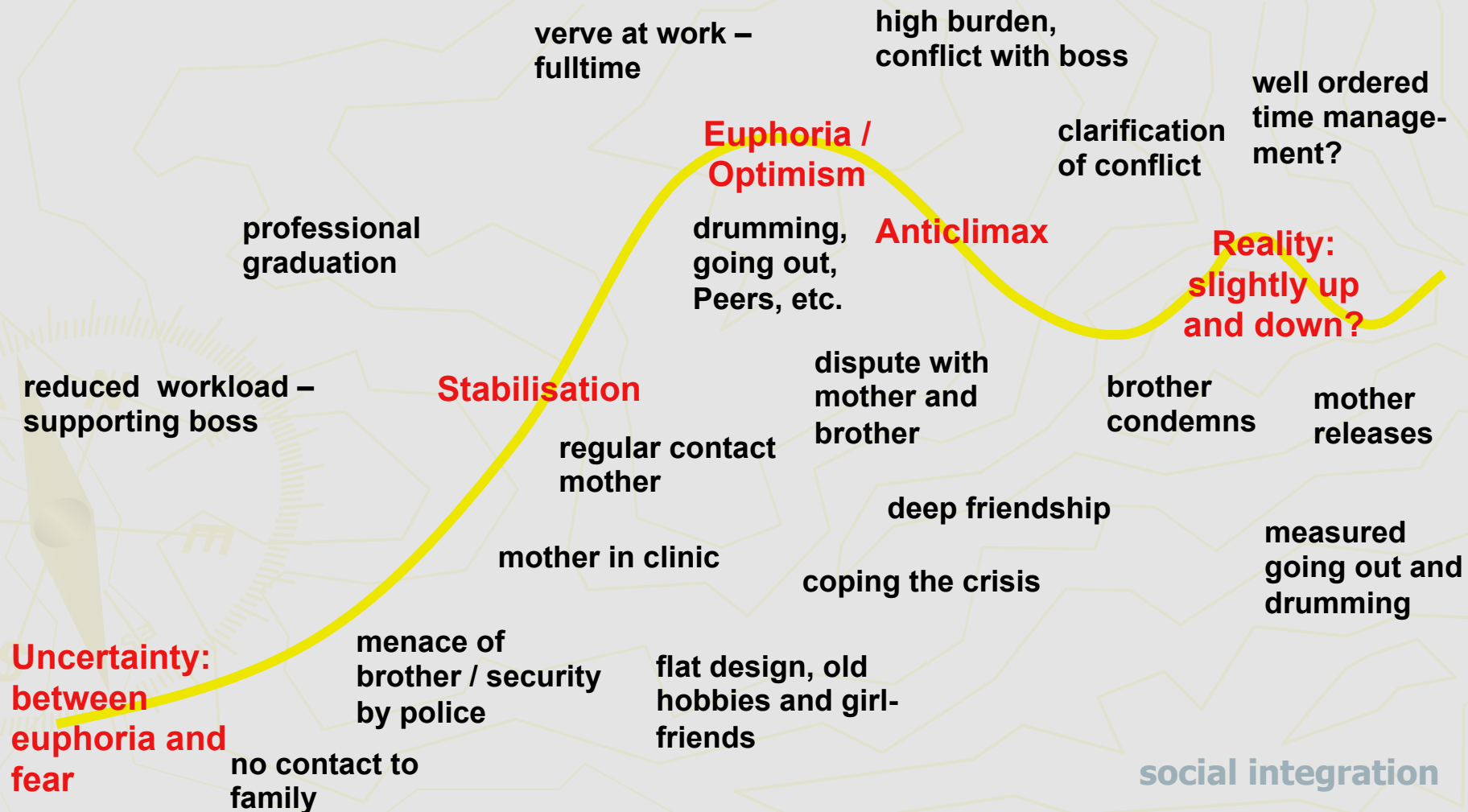
Social Figuration Family System after death of father / Problem Dynamic



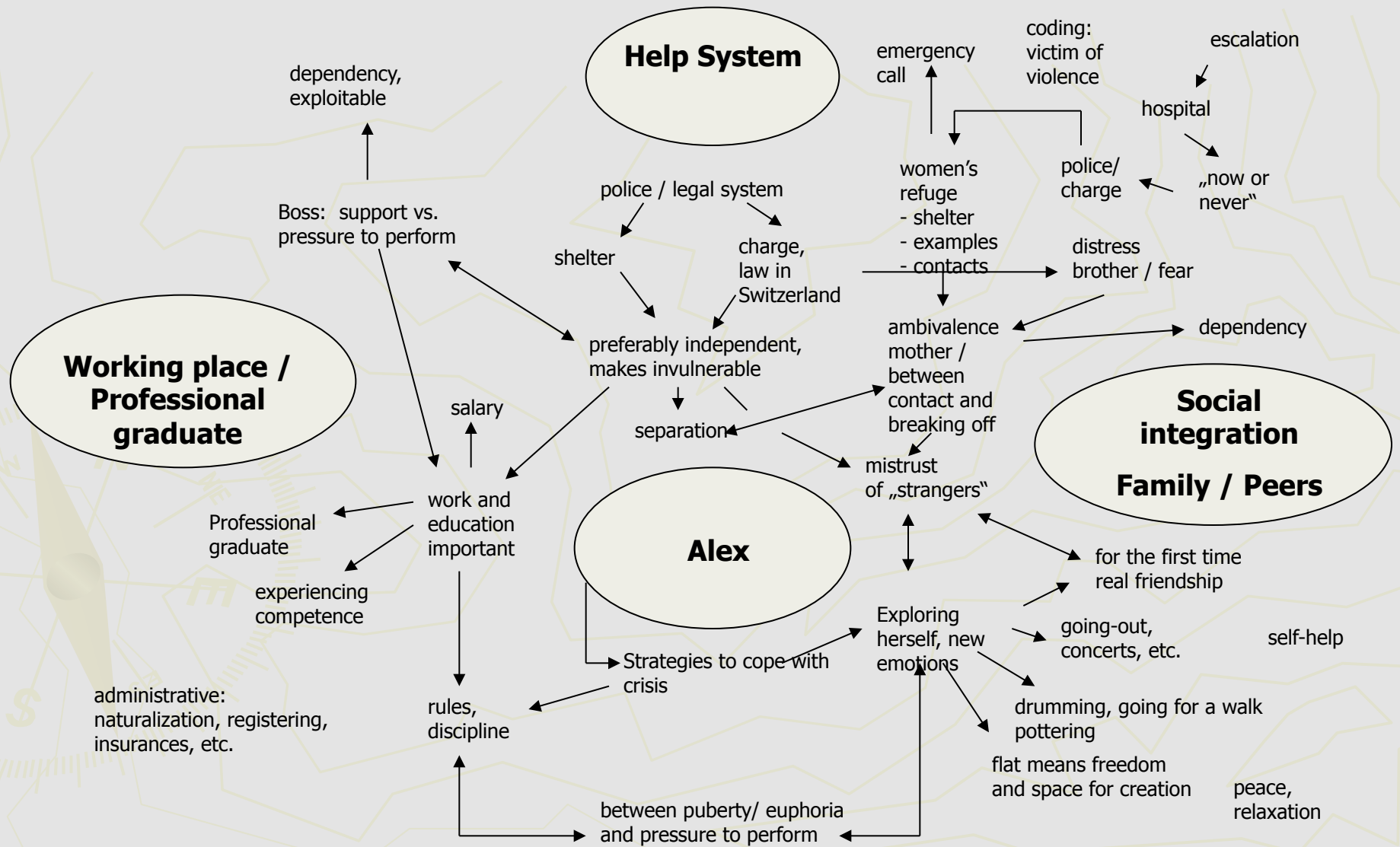

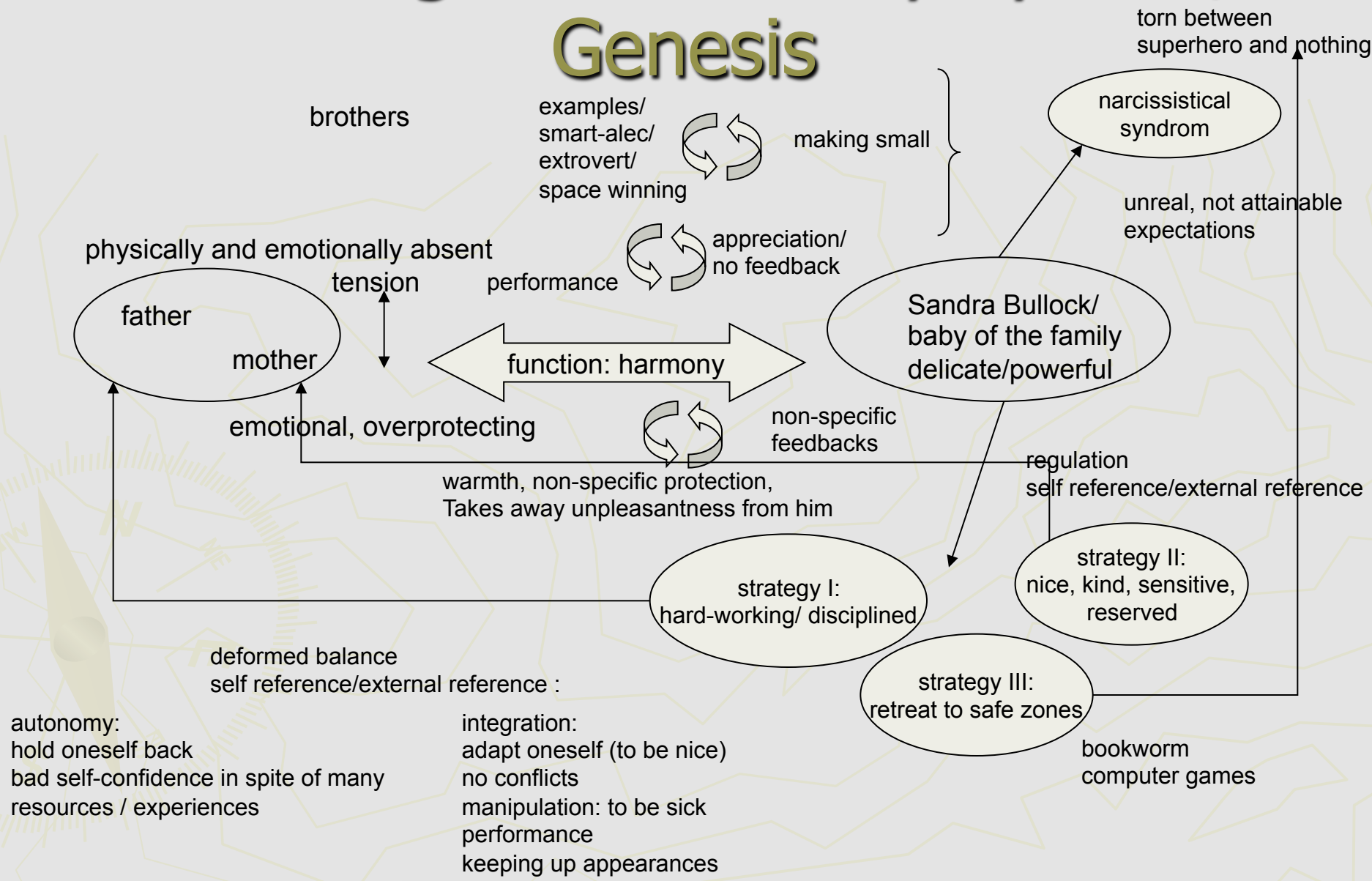

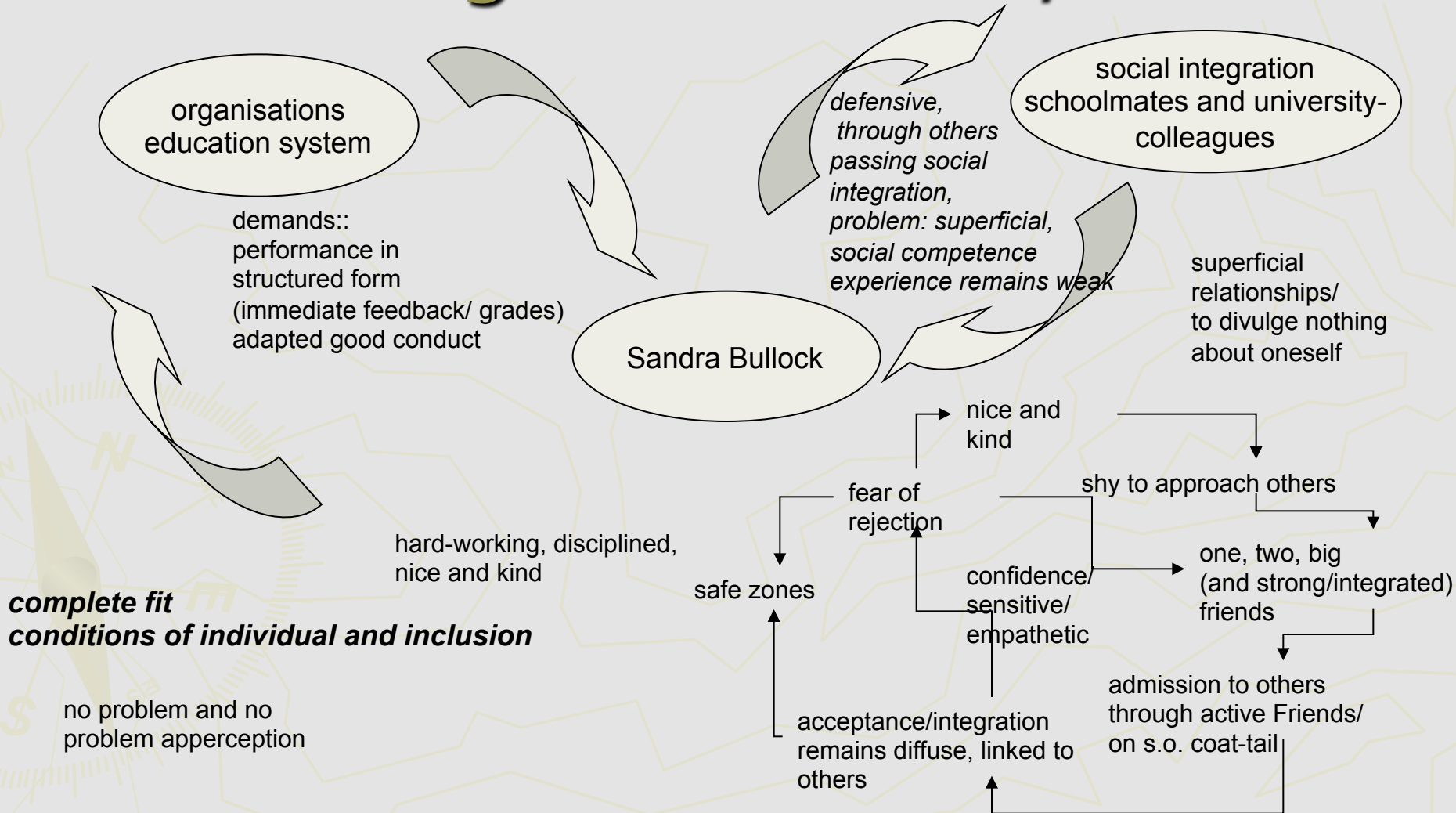

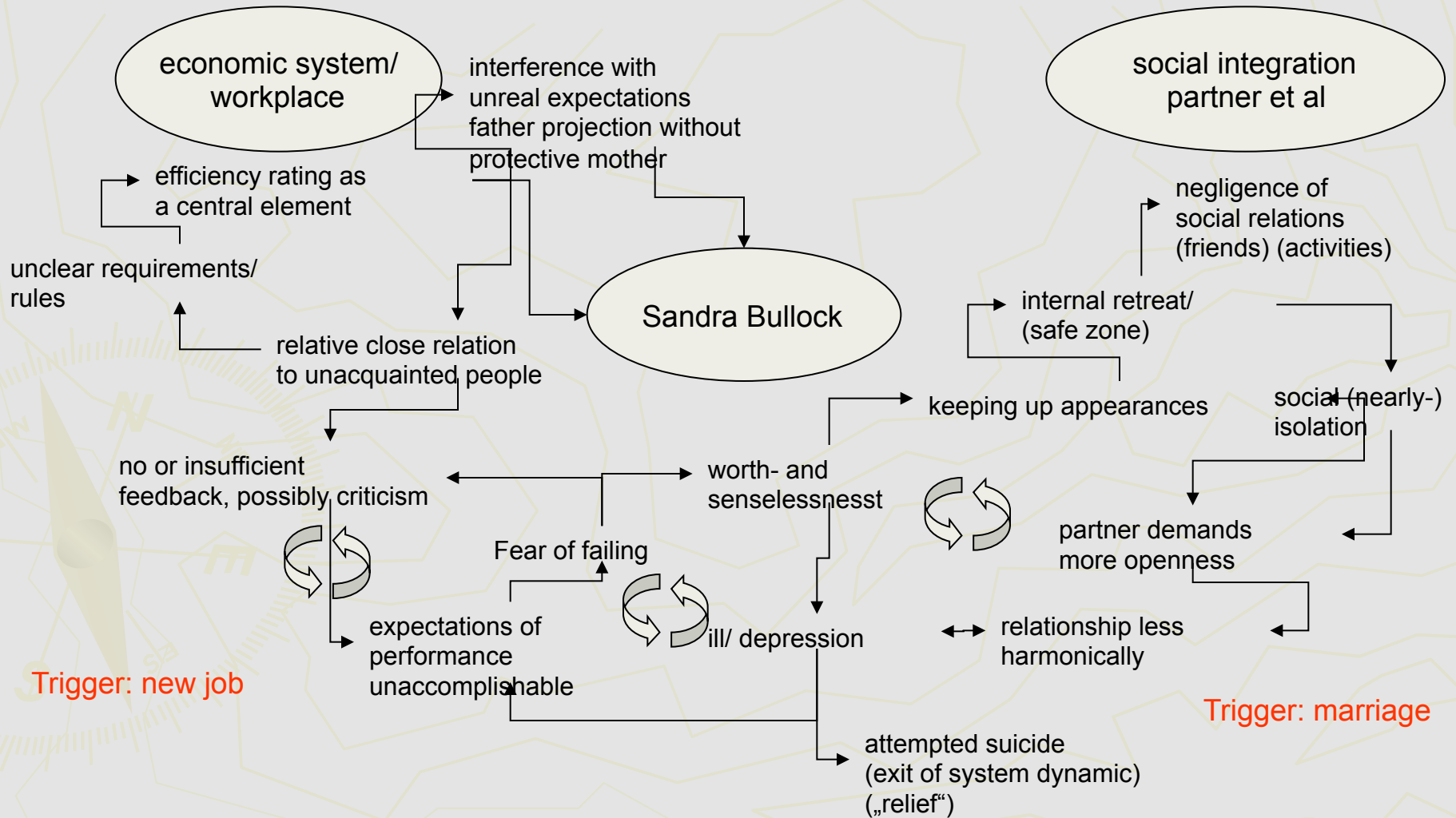
Social Figuration Family System/ Genesis

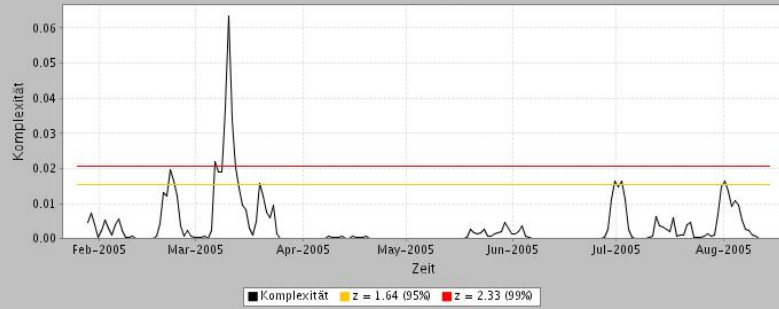

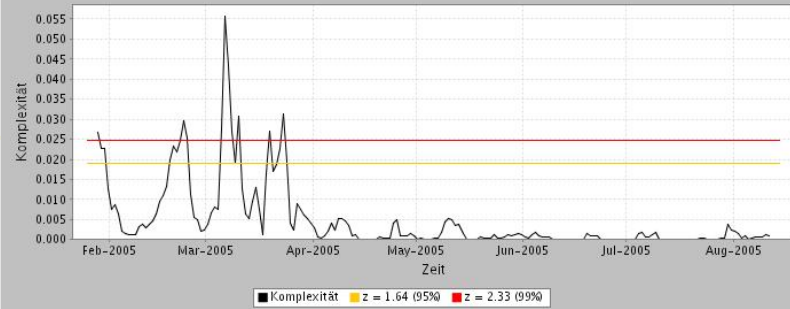
SandraBullock F4: Physische / psychische Befindlichkeit



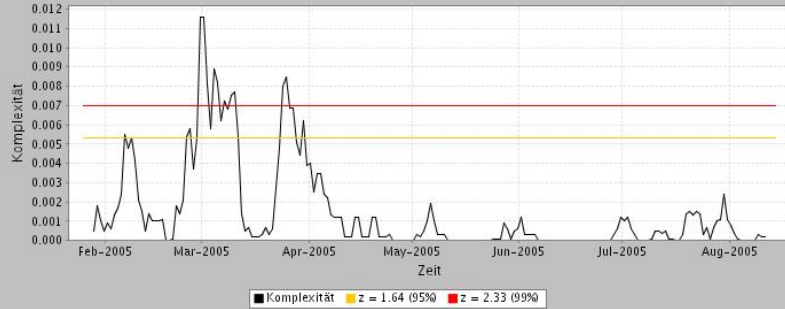

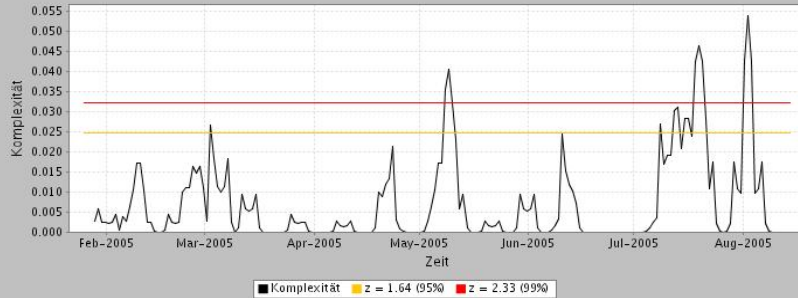

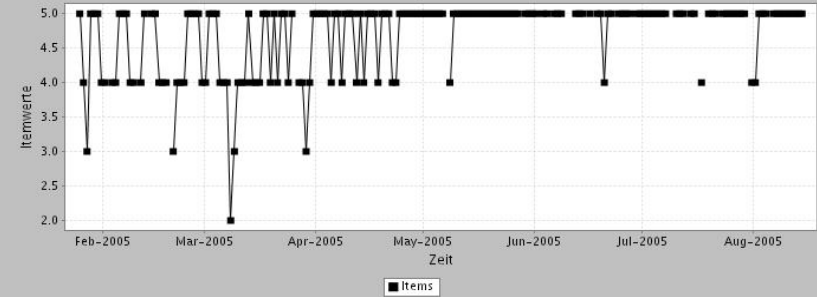

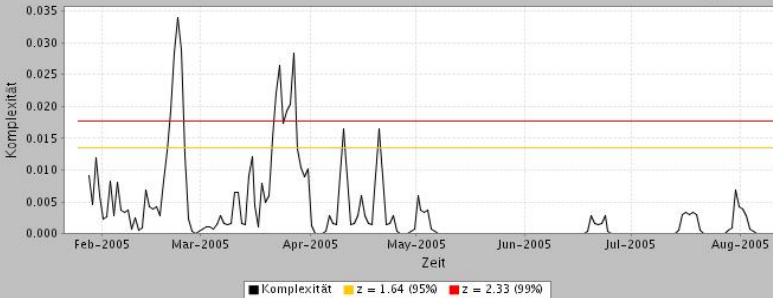

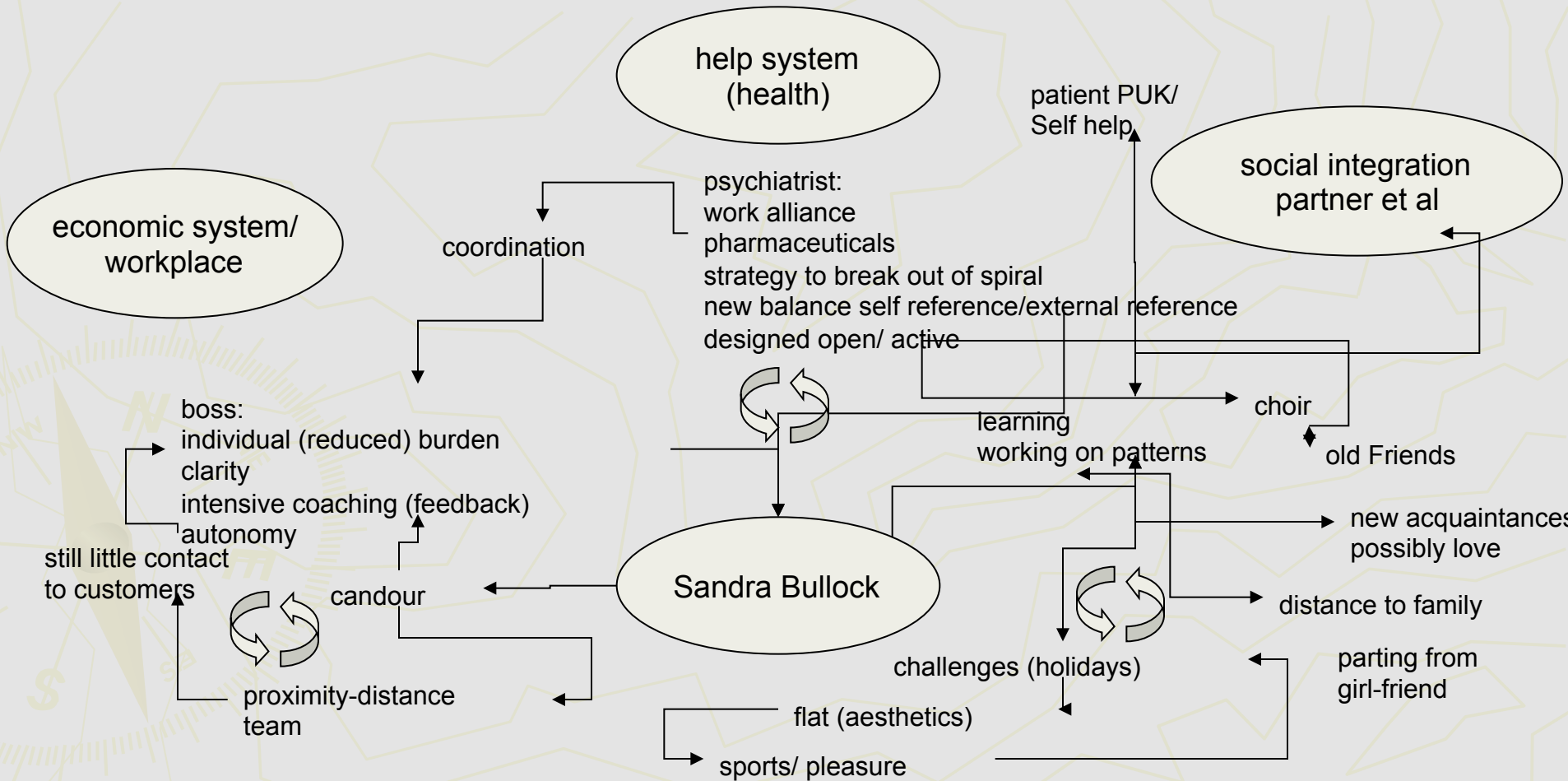
Complexity Processes and recurrence plot Bullock, measures



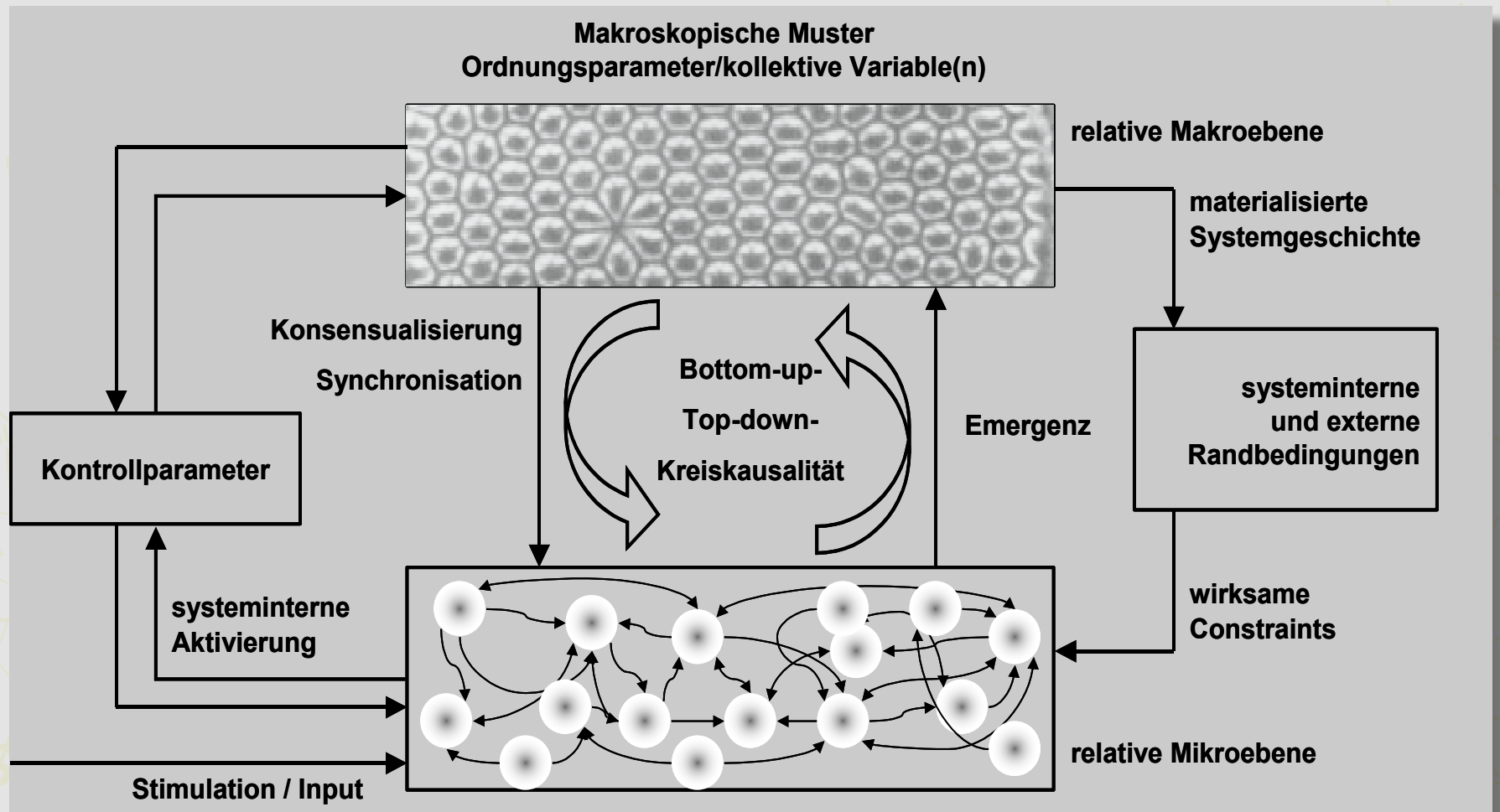

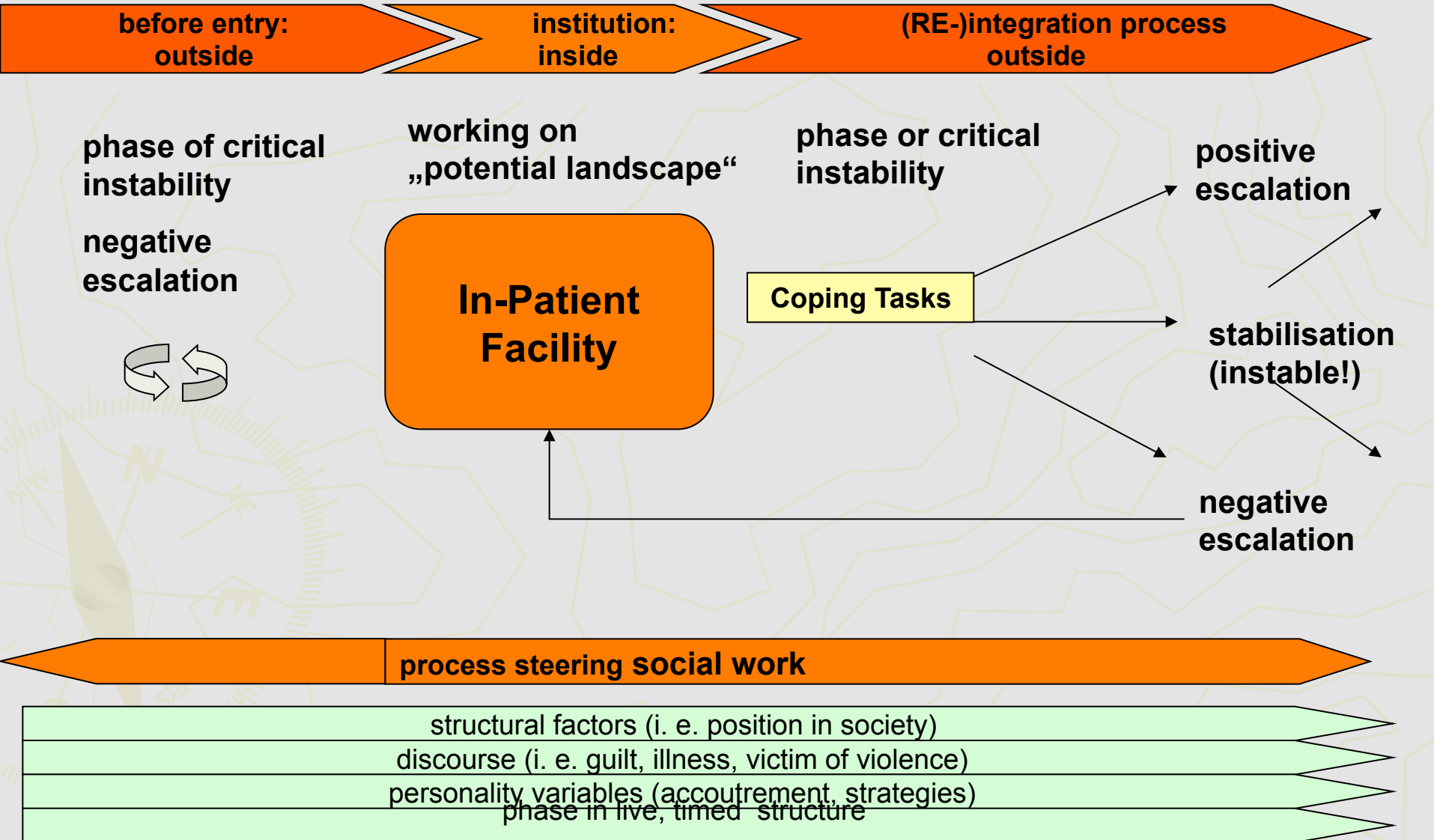

Zirkuläre Kausalität, relative Systemebenen (vgl. Schiepek)



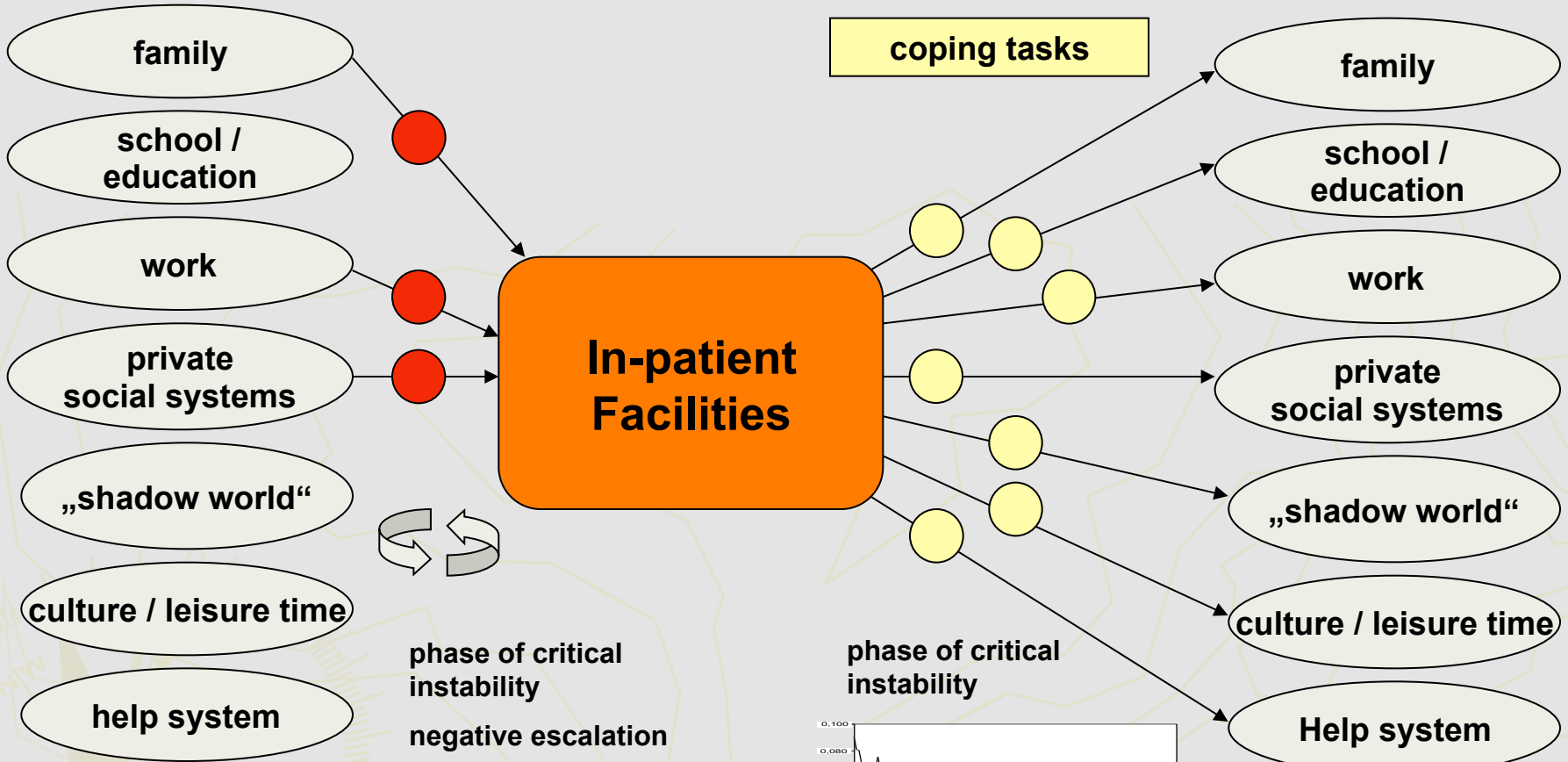

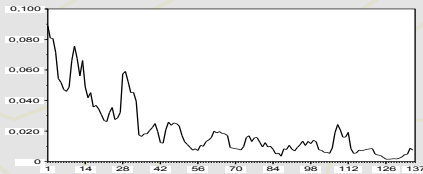
